

What's in the box?

The various kit options and their parts are noted in the table with a diagram on the following page.





- Use the template supplied to mark around and cut-out the shelf from 9mm plywood. (Note the areas that need a chamfer adding).
- Attach the two strengthening ribs in the positions shown, using the screws supplied. (We advise using some PVA glue as well).



Line the plywood with your chosen finish.




- Remove the two plastic caps covering the bolts.
- Remove the rear and loosen the front Torx bolt that secure the OEM grab handle in place.




- Position the right sided front bracket (item 5) between the OEM grab handle and headliner. Slide the bracket forward into position as shown.
 - Refit the rear bolt before tightening both bolts to secure in the bracket in place.
 - Refit the plastic bolt caps.



• Repeat the previous two stages to fit the left sided bracket (item 4).



- Position the right rear bracket in place between the headliner and bodywork rib and fit the flange head bolt into the OEM bulkhead mounting hole.
 - Mark the two rivet holes and drill two Ø4.1mm holes into the bracket.



- Remove the bracket, de-burr the two holes and apply some anti-corrosion paint to the holes.
 - Repeat stage 6 & 7 to prepare the left side rear bracket.



- Take the shelf and slide it into position from the rear, ensuring the front of the shelf sits on the top of the front two brackets.
 - With the shelf in position, re-fit the two rear brackets.



- Fit the four rivets and two bolts to secure the rear brackets in place.
- Ensure the shelf is sitting correctly and use the 8x small screws to secure the four brackets to the shelf.



- The shelf is now installed. If fitting a trim around the bulkhead, the flange head bolts can be removed and bolted through the trim piece.
 - If fitting a surround to the rear of the shelf, use the remaining five screws to secure the strengthening rib to the surround.
